



Warmwell Fishery Rules

- Follow the rules and be respectful to all other anglers.
- All anglers must be in position of your ticket. No tickets will be issued on the lake side.
- All anglers over 13 years old must hold a valid UK rod licence. All Parkdean Resorts staff may request to see proof.
- Anyone under 16 must always have adult supervision.
- Barbless hooks only. Maximum hook size 6.
- Fishery team may request a tackle inspection at any time.
- Fishing is from Dawn to Dusk. No night fishing.
- Maximum of 2 rods per swim and no more than 3m apart.
- Minimum of 22" Landing net and a walled landing mat.
- No bait boats, fixed rigs, lead core, fused leaders or keep nets.
- No plastic baits, Zigs, whole nuts, peas, beans or high oil content pellets (over 35% oil)
- All Method, bomb, cage and leads must be free running or to a bead. A minimum hook length of 9cm may be used with this method.
- Please fish from marked swims only.
- No reserving pegs by leaving unattended tackle in a swim. These will be removed by The Fisheries Team after 1 hour.
- Theft or removal of any fish will be prosecuted.
- No braided main line or fly fishing.
- Do NOT damage any trees or shrubs, No BBQ or open fires on the lake side.
- No Responsibility will be accepted for loss, theft or damage of any tackle/equipment.
- Please remove all litter from your swims and use the bins that are provided.
- Any breaches of our rules will lead to the removal of the right to fish.



Pike Fishing Rules (Oct 1st till March 1st)

- Dead Bait's only. NO Live Baits, Lures, spinners or jigs allowed.
- Treble hooks on dead baits can be semi barbed.
- Minimum of 36" landing net.
- Large well-padded unhooking matt.

Specimen Carping (Heron Lake)

- Minimum of 36" landing net.
- Large walled and well-padded unhooking mat or cradle.
- All weights must be on an ejector clip or free running.
- Rods must have a minimum of 2.5lb test curve.
- Main line minimum of 10lb - No Braided main lines.

We reserve the right to amend the fishery rules at any time and if necessary, without notice.

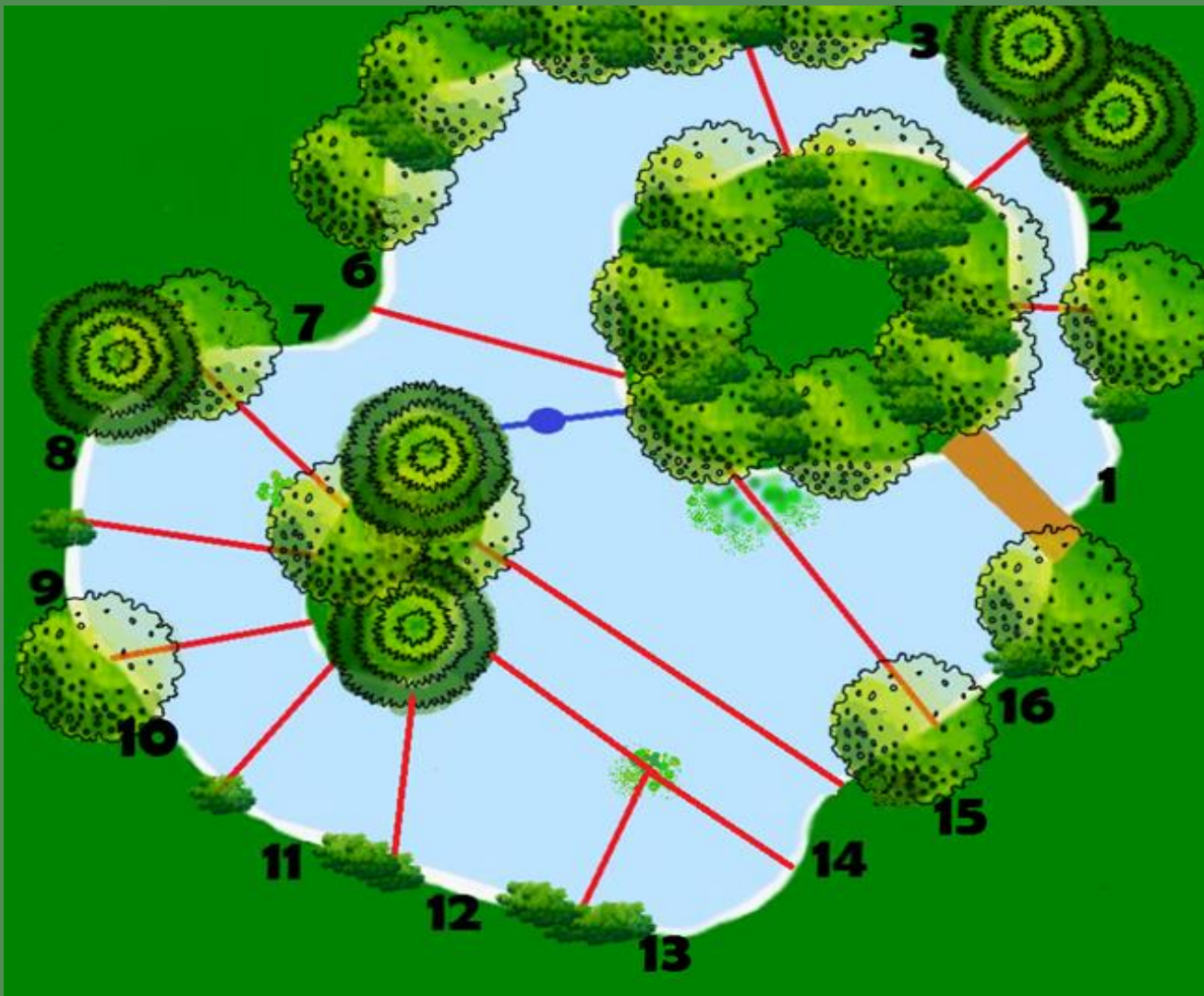
